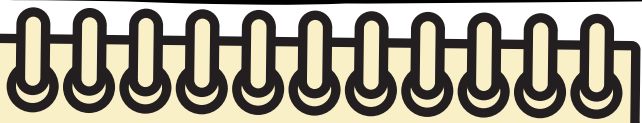

INTRODUCTION

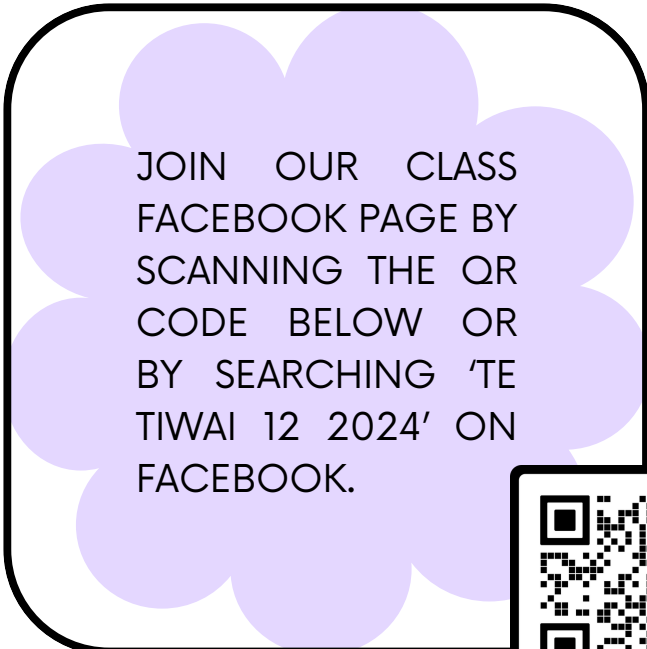
Tēna koutou e te whānau,
