

Allandale School Week 1, Term 4 2023




"Rere atu kia whakairohia to ake ao"

This korero, which is illustrated in the carvings of our waharoa, reflects our intention as a school nurturing learners so that upon leaving Allandale, they are ready to fly off and carve their own futures.

Nga mihi mahana ki a koutou katoa (warm greetings to you all)

Welcome back to what will be an exciting, learning filled term at Allandale School. It is an especially important term for our Year 6 students as they tick off their primary school learning goals and get ready for intermediate. The Whakatāne Intermediate prospectus and enrolment forms have been handed out to our Year 6 tamariki. Please fill them out as soon as possible and return them to the front office. Whakatāne Intermediate will be having an open evening on Tuesday 17th November at 6pm for all whānau who would like to attend. Year 6 tamariki will be attending the open day on Wednesday 18th October.

Attendance at school matters, every day matters. Our goal is to have our children here at school, learning, at least 90% of the time. That means a child is away on average no more than 1 day each fortnight. As you can see from the graph below this week we fell just short of this target with 88% attendance. Let's see if we can get 90% or more next week.



Emergency plan

Here's what we do at Allandale School if there is an emergency.

 If there is a fire, the alarms go off and we all immediately evacuate the buildings and assemble on the school field at the Emergency Assembly Point



- If there is an earthquake we 'drop, cover and hold' until we know that the tremors have stopped. At that point we assemble at the Emergency Assembly Point to check that everyone is safe and accounted for.
- 3. Civil Defence have recently updated the tsunami evacuation maps. Allandale School is in the tsunami safe zone which means we wouldn't necessarily evacuate if there is an earthquake. However, if there is a Whakatāne-wide evacuation order (i.e. similar to the 2021 event) head to 55 Valley Road
- 4. If we have a lock-down, which may be activated by a chemical spill, everyone on the school site remains locked in and safe. No-one can come in or out until we get the all clear from the authorities.

As our ancestors have been telling us "He waka eke noa" - we're all in this together.
