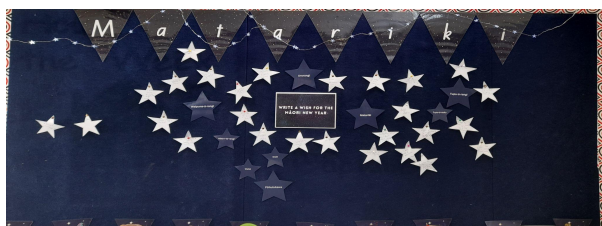


School Attendance
