Teacher planning is about

- The direction that the teacher needs to have about where the learning is headed and this is based on evidence through assessment data.

What the teacher needs to do in order to effectively communicate the direction to students

What do you think you are learning?

Why do you think you are learning this?

How will you know you have learnt it? How do you know you are getting better at

What do you think you need to do now to get better at improve your learning in ...

Planning for learning at Allandale School has 2 components:

- 1) Long term planning
- 2) Weekly planning

Long Term Planning

Teachers use Allandale School's long term planning procedure to ensure that curriculum coverage is achieved.

Weekly Planning

Teachers use their weekly planning to ensure that specific skills are taught to meet the needs of their students.
